Boliden’s Mikael Staffas elected as new Eurometaux President

Brussels, 23 October 2018 – Mikael Staffas, President and CEO of Boliden AB, was elected as President of Eurometaux, the European non-ferrous metals association, during the association’s General Assembly on 18 October in Brussels.

Guy Thiran, Eurometaux’s Director General, commented: “Mikael Staffas will lead Eurometaux through an important period of European political transition. Next year will see the election of new European politicians, and a refreshed EU legislative programme. Previously he worked as CFO for Södra Skogsägarna as well as partner at McKinsey & Co. Mikael Staffas holds a M.Sc. Engineering from Royal Institute of Technology and a MBA from INSEAD.
